Upholstery

Introducing Japanese Sashiko embroidery to help you mend your clothes with creativity. Inspired by nature and geometric patterns, this timeless craft brings together patching, mending and embroidery together.

At the end of the workshop, you will leave with your mended garment or the sampler you worked on and the knowledge to mend and look after your clothes.



Glass fusing

Create a stunning and unique piece of handmade glass, in this mindful exercise.

Everyone works together towards the same goal whilst taking time out to bond, relax and rejuvenate.

The resulting artwork can be installed in the workplace, with each team member having contributed.





Forest bathing

Nature immersion (inspired by the Japanese practice of Shinrin Yoku) is a unique, memorable and meaningful nature experience that connects your team on a deeper level than anything else and creates powerful, positive, long-lasting change for mental and physiological health.



Origami

Origami is the mindful art-form of folding paper. It promotes patience, visualisation and benefits hand/eye coordination. It is also a great tool for making connections as colleagues help each other.



Painting

Learn how to 'see' the landscape, natural forms – including sheep – in a different and totally creative way.

At the end of the workshop everyone will have done several charcoal drawings and at least one mixed media painting.

Groups can work on larger creations using mixed media.



Candle making

Walk away with your very own handmade candle and a newfound appreciation for the artistry involved in crafting these exquisite creations. A chance to indulge in some well-deserved relaxation while exploring your creative side.

Flax into fibre

See how this amazing seed is far more than something to be sprinkled on your breakfast cereals.

Learn how to beat, crimp, scrape and comb the flax and see how long fibres are twisted into a fine thread, which is what makes linen.

Work in pairs using short fibres to form a twine and as a team create a rope.





Sheep grooming

Prepare a sheep as if for showing. Activities include carding, washing its fleece, washing its horns and trimming its fleece to shape it.

Working in pairs, see who can impress the shepherd the most.
Which one will be top dog - er, sheep?



Working with wool

Learn about and undertake the manual processing of the world's most natural textile – a sheep's fleece. Wash and card the wool then learn the heritage crafts of spinning or peg-loom weaving.
